THU, MAY 11 OVERNIGHT TRANSATLANTIC FLIGHT TO WARSAW (NOT INCLUDED IN THE LAND TOUR PRICE)

FRI, MAY 12 ARRIVE WARSAW (Welcome dinner)

Transfer to our hotel and enjoy the afternoon at your leisure.

In the evening join us for our Welcome dinner to meet the group – old friends and new!

SAT, MAY 13 WARSAW (Breakfast, Lunch)

Our walking tour of the Old town includes the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, Castle Square, Old Town Square. We continue by coach for a driving tour that takes us past the Palace of Science and Culture, the former Warsaw Ghetto and National Opera House. Stopping at Lazienki Park to see the famous Chopin Monument and stroll through this wonderful green space in the heart of Warsaw to see the Palace on the Water. Our next stop will be the increasingly trendy "Praga" district of Warsaw. Here we will visit the newly opened Polish Vodka Museum and end our tour today with lunch at one of the popular restaurants in Praga.

After lunch enjoy the rest of the day exploring Warsaw at your leisure. Perhaps visit one of Warsaw's fine museums.

MON, MAY 15 WARSAW – LOWICZ – WROCLAW (Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast we leave Warsaw and drive west stopping to visit the Open-air museum of Łowicz's Folk Culture in Maurzyce which is located on the outskirts of Lowicz. Lunch at a local inn and then we continue to Wroclaw.

After checking in to our hotel the evening is free to relax or enjoy at a café in Wroclaw's old town square.

TUE, MAY 16 WROCLAW (Breakfast, Dinner)

Wroclaw, the city of bridges - built on 12 islands and connected by 112 bridges!

Our walking tour will start in the oldest part of the city "Ostrow Tumski" (Cathedral Island), one of the most beautiful and perfectly preserved sacral architecture complexes in Europe. Cross "lover's bridge" and visit the colorful market hall before arriving at the Old Town Market Square where we end our tour. Wroclaw is famous for its little "gnomes", so be careful where you step! Dinner tonight at a local restaurant featuring local delicacies of the region.

WED, MAY 17 WROCLAW – TYCHY – ZAKOPANE (Breakfast, Brewery tour & Tasting)

Today we leave Wroclaw and drive to the southernmost part of Poland. Enroute we will stop in Tychy, for a tour of the "Tyskie" brewery including beer tasting before arriving Zakopane in the late afternoon. Evening to enjoy Zakopane on your own.

THU, MAY 18 ZAKOPANE (Breakfast, Dinner with folklore)

After breakfast see the highlights of Zakopane including the wooden chapel at Jaszczurowka, the ski-jump hill, and the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima. Our tour will end with a cable car (funicular) ride to the top of Gubalowka Mountain for a great view of the Tatra Mountains. After descending from Gubalowka you have free time to shop the colorful open market place where you will find leather goods, sheepskin items, local cheese, and all kinds of wonderful gifts and souvenirs for yourself and for friends at home. In the early evening we will take a short drive to the village of Chocholow famous for its unique log-houses. We will stop to visit a local wood-carver and afterwards we enjoy dinner at a nearby highlander inn with lively music and folklore.

FRI, MAY 19 ZAKOPANE – SPLYW DUNAJCA - KRAKOW (Breakfast, Lunch)

In the morning we leave Zakopane and take a short drive to enjoy a relaxing and picturesque river rafting experience on the Dunajec River (weather permitting). Winding through the spectacular scenery of the Pieniny National Park we will be zig-zagging back and forth across the Polish and Slovak border. Lunch at a local inn and then we continue our drive to Krakow. After checking in to our hotel enjoy the ambience of Krakow's old town at your leisure.
