Is the 11 year old son for former Crusade trumpet man Brian Galuzny. Now please meet Mighty Micah.



Micah has always been a very extraordinary little guy. With a killer sense of humor, a smile that could charm even the hardest of hearts, and a soul that overflows with love and faith... the world looked to be open to whatever incredible impact Micah would eventually have on it.

On Monday, October 10th, a colossal roadblock appeared in Micah's path. That day, Micah and our family received the devastating news that what was thought to be a harmless bump on his foot was actually cancer.

After several tests and a biopsies, it was determined that the cancer that had developed inside both of Micah's legs was metastatic Alveolar Rhabdomyosarcoma or ARMS, a rare type of cancer that forms in soft tissue, specifically skeletal muscle tissue. It was also determined more recently that the cancer was present in his arms, pancreas, and spine.

It is early in this battle, and we are learning a little more each hour about our enemy. That said, the one thing we do know is that this war will be tough on Micah and his parents. A mountain of issues and concerns come with news like this, not the smallest of which is financial. Micah has five young siblings, and his hospital is an hour's drive from home.
